

- Faculty Salaries: \$221,000
- Staff Salaries: \$80,000
- Graduation Funding: \$343,103
- Office of Research Administration: \$84,150
- Budget cut absorbed centrally: \$54,000
- Total increase in base funding: \$590,103
- Total new funds: \$1,156,612





SCH Issues

- On average, 60% of SCH money generated by non-tenure track faculty
- Considerable variability in teaching loads among tenure track faculty
 - Range of SCH funds generated
- Needs to be related to research and service activity

Returned Overhead to College

- \$875,715.53 X .15 = \$131,357
- Distribution to departments: 57%
 - **\$74, 873**
- Retained in college: 43%
 - **\$56, 483**
 - Start-up and research incentive program





- If at average for Pac-12
 - Total returned overhead/year: \$1,872,820
 - Returned overhead to college: \$280,923
 - Distributed to departments: \$160,126
 - Retained in college: \$120,796





Impact of Research Incentive

- Implications
 - Proposals submitted
 - 2008-2009: \$15,362,954
 - 2009-2010: \$30,308,563 (98% increase)
 - 2010-2011: \$25,979,454 (through 7 months)





Likely Funding 2011-2012

- Psychology
 - Highly scored grants totaling \$12 Million +
 - Partnership with AAA Foundation in development
- FCS
 - Barbara Brown project funded at \$2.9 Million
- DoD Funding
 - Partner in \$12 Million DoD consortium

Distribution of Funds in College

- Political Science
 - Supplement to partially funded line
 - Supplemented Maxwell chair to facilitate hire
 - Absorbed line for merit pay
- Psychology
 - Supplemented absorbed line for equity and merit pay
 - Additional funds for TA stipends





- Geography
 - Funded faculty line
- Anthropology
 - Funds available to supplement current hiring or shared line
- Sociology
 - Funds available for hiring external chair
 - Shared position with gender studies
 - New position from Japan Foundation grant





• FCS

- New part-time tenure line position
- Shared auxiliary position with COE
- Economics
 - Returned most of previously lost base funds
- Sustainability and Environmental Studies
 - First ever faculty line, shared position with Humanities





Priorities

- Targeted Merit and Equity Pay in Departments and Units
 - Research productivity
 - Expansion of SCH productivity, recognition and reward
 - Recognition of service
- Development of targeted faculty positions (based on department performance)
- Development of research infrastructure and productivity
 - Office of Research Administration
- Reconnecting with undergraduate base
 - Student Ambassador Program
 - Student Focus Groups, Welcome and Graduation Events
- Broad development activities for college
