

# JAMESON FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

The *Jameson Family Scholarship* awards one two-semester scholarship valued at \$6,600 and one one-semester scholarship valued at \$3,300, which applies to the student's college tuition.

## WHO QUALIFIES?

To be eligible for the *Jameson Family Scholarship*, an individual must:

1. have been accepted as an HB144 student by the University of Utah
2. have completed at least one year at the University of Utah
3. be a motivated student with a good academic record
4. have financial need
5. be enrolled as full-time (12 credits or more) at the time the award is used

Preference will be given to:

- Latino/a students
- students who are majoring in the College of Social and Behavioral Science
- students who have been involved in leadership and/or community activities
- students who have applied for Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)
- students who graduated from Wayne County High School (although scholarship eligibility will not be limited to these students alone)
